



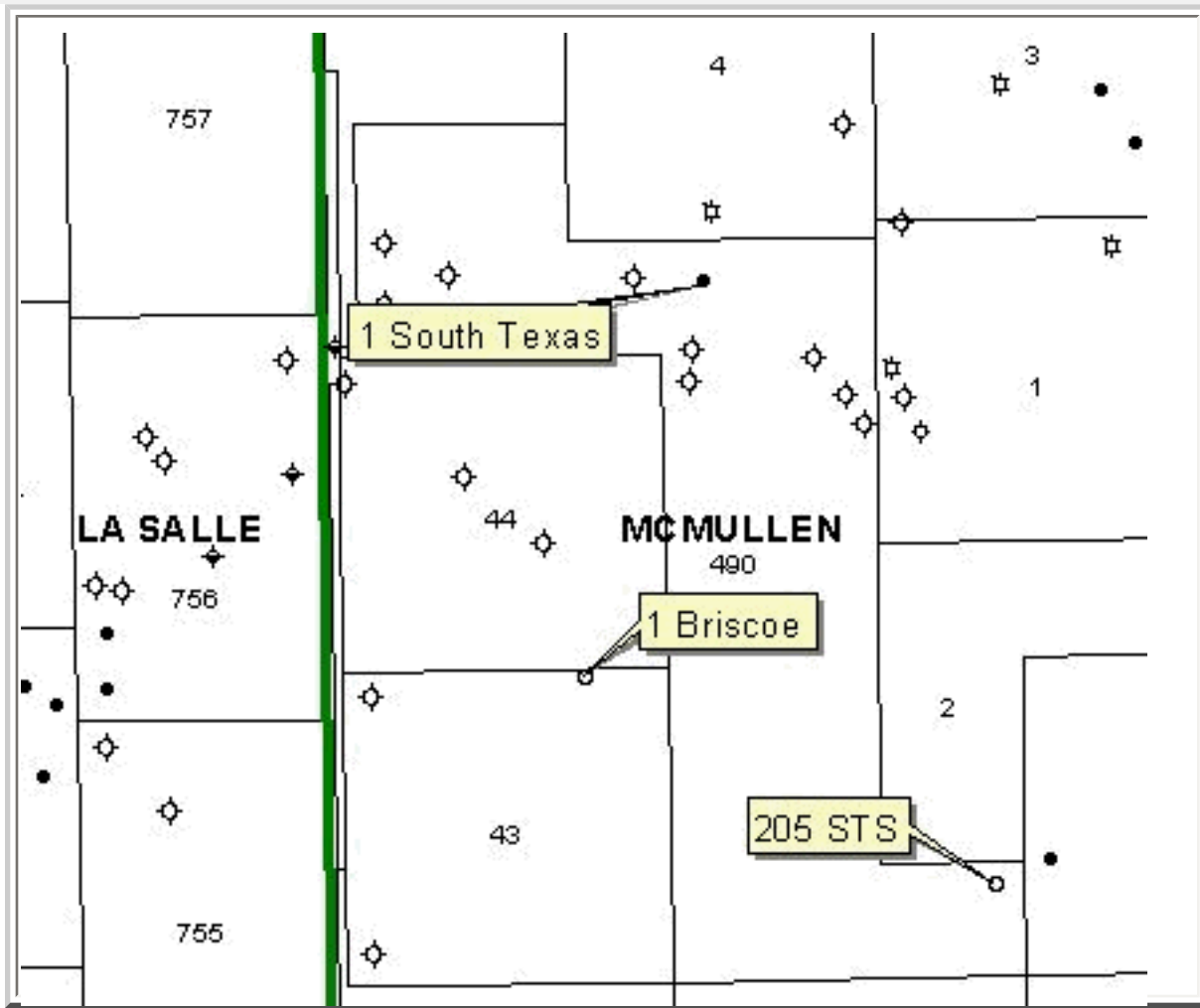

Title: Apparent Wilcox wildcat scheduled by Welder in McMullen County

Seventeen miles southwest of Tilden, Texas, a wildcat has been permitted by San Antonio-based Welder Exploration & Production Inc in the western portion of McMullen County (RRC Dist. 1).

Plans call for the 1 Briscoe (API 42-311-34125) to be drilled to a total depth of 6000 ft. Located less than a mile east of the La Salle County line, it is apparently targeting the Wilcox on a 483-acre lease in section 43, BS&F survey, A-581.

Comparable production is one and a quarter miles to the northeast in section 490, R.C. Pullen survey, A-858. In 1985, Chanoco Corp completed the 1 South Texas Syndicate '490' at a total depth of 6000 ft. The lone producer in Telephone Post field, it was tested flowing 93 bbls of 46-degree crude and 185,000 cu ft of casinghead gas daily through perforations at 5460-64 ft. Log tops included the Crockett at 1375 ft, Sparta Sand at 1615 ft, Queen City at 1873 ft and Carrizo at 3467 ft. Online through 1999, the discovery recovered a total of 51,242 bbls of oil, 154.83 million cu ft of casinghead gas and 4,137 bbls of water.

Blackbrush Oil & Gas Inc has also permitted a test in the area. Located in section 5, BS&F survey, A-104, the 205 STS (API 42-311-33978) is slated to reach a total depth of 9200 ft in the Olmos.
